DEVOTIONAL EXCERPT

During a time, of upheaval, praying through <u>Psalm 131</u> helped to trust God while also not closing off emotions.

Although the psalm is short, God's peace is received through it, namely this verse: "But I have calmed and quietened myself, I am like a weaned child with its mother; like a weaned child I am content." (Psalm 131:2).

We too can join David in this song of ascents, part of a collection of psalms the pilgrims sang as they travelled to Jerusalem.

But God will help us in this also. When we affirm that we won't puff ourselves up (v. 1) while we seek His guidance, He will lead us to contentment, understanding and peace.
