DEVOTIONAL EXCERPT

Saul had been on his way to persecute Christians when Christ intervened. This man fell to the ground, blinded (Acts 9:1-9).

Soon he was visited by Ananias, who restored his sight and explained his mission: "The God of our ancestors has chosen you to know his will and to see the Righteous One and to hear words from his mouth.

You will be his witness to all people of what you have seen and heard" (22:14-15). Saul, later called Paul, did witness, and God gave him a quiverful of spiritual offspring. His "parenting approach" was to share what he'd seen, and to pray.

We witness with our words and lives as to what we've seen and heard. And we pray. Our God, who sent Paul to the gentiles, sends us with the same instruction: Witness so they may believe. Then entrust them to our Father, who loves them.

“You will be Jesus' witness to all people of what you have seen and heard. Acts 22:15.”
